2009 MOBILE DATA COMPUTER PURCHASE

I request the purchase of seven Motorola mobile data computers ("MDC's") be added to the Douglas County Commission's consent agenda. These MDC's will be purchased from TFM Communications via state contract number 28440 at a cost of \$36,090.60. The funding for four of the computers was previously approved by the Board of County Commissioners in the 2009 Sheriff's Office budget and is contained within line item 81300. The funding for the additional three computers was obtained through a non-matching Department of Justice COPS technology grant.

This purchase is necessary to replace existing mobile data computers that have been in use for approximately six years. Our existing system is comprised of Motorola computers and the proprietary software that is required to establish communications with the network.

I have included copies of the vendor information and price quotation with this request. In addition to the prices listed on the quotation, \$195.00 was added to the cost of each computer in order to add an expansion port, bringing the total cost for this request to \$37,455.60. Abutment modifications and deck repairs

Route 458 bridges over Wakarusa River and Rock Arms of Clinton Lake

Bridge Nos. 10.92-03.46 and 09.64-04.82

The bid opening for the referenced project is scheduled for 3:00 pm this Thursday, August 13. In order to complete this project this construction season, it is important the contractor begin work no later than August 31. In an effort to expedite beginning construction, we wish to put awarding a contract on the Monday, August 17 agenda.

Following the bid opening we will prepare a tabulation of bids, and will email the bid tabulation to each commissioner for consideration prior to Monday's meeting.

The project includes removing both expansion joints for Bridge No. 09.64-04.82 (Rock Creek arm). For Bridge No. 10.92-03.46 (Wakarusa River arm), the project includes removing the expansion joint at the southeast abutment and replacing the expansion joint at the northwest abutment. The project also includes abutment modifications, deck repairs, silica fume concrete overlays, and asphalt approach transitions for both bridges. The project will address the failed expansion joints and delaminated concrete decks for both bridges.

Project No. 2009-6

On August 6, we received bids from four contractors for the referenced project (see attached tabulation). The project includes asphalt overlay work and paving shoulders on Route 458 from 1500 feet east of US-59 highway to Route 1055 (E 1500 Road), and milling and overlaying Route 1055 from Route 458 to 31st Street.

RD Johnson is the low bidder with a total bid of \$608,767.36. The Engineer's Estimate was \$782,644.30. RD Johnson's bid for the Route 458 portion and the Route 1055 portion were \$331,313.20 and \$277,454.16, respectively.

As you will recall, the Route 458 portion will be funded by the CIP. The CIP includes \$500,000 for the Route 458 portion. The Route 1055 portion will be paid from Road & Bridge Fund 201. The Overlay line item in Fund 201 allocates \$459,360 for contract overlay work.

We recommend awarding a contract to the low bidder, RD Johnson Excavating. We also request authorization to approve change orders totaling up to 5% of the contract amount.
