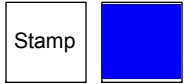

Instructions

Use black or blue ink pen  
Fill in the oval to the left of your choice  
To write-in, fill in oval to the left of line and add name  
If you make a mistake, ask for a new ballot

Official Instructions

To vote for a person, darken the oval to the left of the person's name.  
To vote for a person whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the person's name in the blank space and darken the oval to the left.  
To vote for presidential electors for candidates for president and vice-president darken the oval to the left of the names of the candidates.  
To vote for presidential electors to be selected by candidates for president and vice-president whose names are not printed on the ballot, write the persons' names in the appropriate blank spaces and darken the oval to the left of the names of the candidates.  
Notice: If you tear, deface, or make a mistake and wrongfully mark any ballot, you must return it to the election board and receive a new ballot or ballots
